Cherry Finch



The Plum-headed Finch (Neochmia modesta)

Description: The Plum-headed Finch (*Neochmia modesta*) also known as Cherry Finch is a common species of estrildid finch found in Australia. It is found in dry savannah and subtropical/tropical (lowland) dry shrubland in Australia. Cherry Finches for sale prefer an aviary with shrubs and tall growing grasses.

Geography: Australia

Song/Call: Click to hear the song of the Cherry Finch

Size: 4.33"

Lifespan: 7 to 8 years

Sexing: The Cherry Finches are easily sexed. The female is similar to the male but lacks the male's black chin spot.

Temperament: Cherry Finches are non aggressive in a mixed aviary. They are hardy birds who breed well and are happiest in a small aviary or large planted aviary.

Breeding: The plum-headed finch breeds mainly from September to January in the south and from August to March in the north. The nest is round, laterally compressed chamber of green grass and is built in thick bushes. Four to six pure white eggs are laid. They will breed all year round if conditions are suitable and a compatible pair would be good for a beginner / intermediate level bird-keeper. Can be bred as a colony or one pair can be bred in a large canary style cage.

Diet: <u>Classic Finch Seed</u>, <u>Australian Blend Goldenfeast</u>, <u>Dried Egg Food</u>, <u>Mineral Grit</u>, <u>Millet Sprays</u>, <u>Cuttlefish Bone</u>

Spanish Timbrado Canary



The Spanish Timbrado Canary is the newest breed of song canary, developed in Spain in the 1940's and 1950's. It is also considered to be the purest domestic form of canary. Being closest genetically to the original wild canary as it was developed by crossing the wild canary with the song bird of Spain.

The name Timbrado derives from the timbre of the canary's metallic voice, reminiscent of castanets, the traditional instruments used in much of Spain's folk music.

The song of this canary consists of twelve notes. Their song must be loud, metallic, bright, and harmonious. Negatives in the song are screeches, strained sounds, and nasal sounds. Standards for three types of songs have been established; the original known as 'Classical' line, the 'Floreado line', and the 'Intermediate' line which falls between the other two. This canaries can be trained to sing on cue.

Canaries of both sexes can begin to sing a weak song as early as four weeks. However, females usually don't sing until after about six months and won't have the full long song of a male.

These are songbirds and are to be enjoyed as such. They don't like to be handled, but should be enjoyed for their beautiful song.
