Meet our April 18th CFS 2nd Annual Spring Show Judge

As a boy growing up in rural Indiana, I was fascinated with birds. Early on my bird-life began with the breeding and releasing of game birds. To that activity, I added raising pigeons that I captured by raiding nests at a nearby commercial grain elevator. Over time, I moved on to breeding and keeping Roller and Tumbler pigeons and it was during this time that I became involved in bird clubs.

Around the age of 12, I got to know an elderly couple who shared with me their hobby of raising finches. Every Saturday, they would hang out a sign on their mailbox, sell a few birds and then go fishing. Hank and Sadie took me under their wing and patiently taught me everything they knew. They were a blessing to me and I have been passionate about finches, softbills, and canaries ever since.

Over the years wherever I lived, I have been fortunate to keep many varieties of birds. My experience ranges from doves and game birds to Rollulus Rouloul partridges and includes more than 100 species of finches and softbills. I moved to Oregon in 2000 and for nearly 10 years maintained a large aviary which housed as many as 2000+ birds. We have downsized Jeepers Peepers and I am currently working with a variety of approximately 200 birds which include species such as English Zebras, Owls, Lady Gouldians, Stars, Shaftails, Firetails, Cherries, and Societies. No matter the numbers, I am still fascinated and fulfilled working with brids and they teach me something new every day. I believe in breeding to standard and I am dedicated to providing the best care possible for my feathered friends who continue to bring me great satisfaction, peace and purpose.

I enjoy attending birds shows as well as showing my birds. I have competed on a local level, at other NW shows and bird shows across the United States. My birds have won many top ten bench awards and I am very proud to have been awarded the NFSS Breeder of Excellence Award. I am a longtime member of NFSS, the National Finch & Softbill Society and I highly recommend that all finch and softbill enthusiasts join. Membership to local and national bird clubs offers many personal benefits, but more important by doing so, you are helping to further aviculture.
